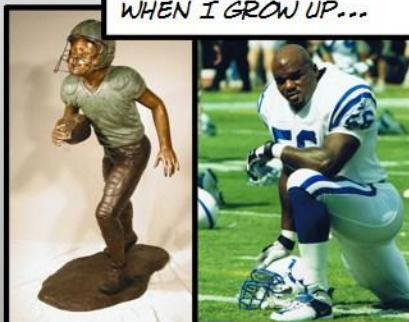
FACTS AND STATS:
